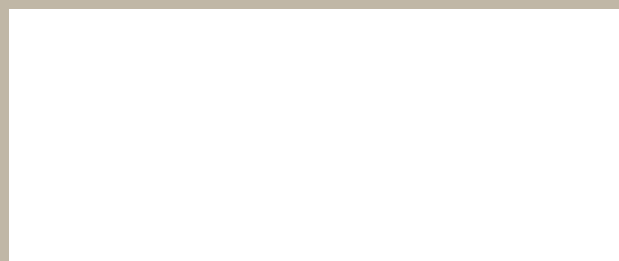

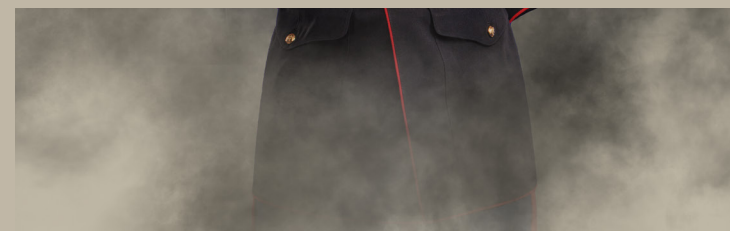

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Age - Must qualify for nonregular retired pay by age 60.
- Physical - Must meet height/weight and current medical requirements.
- Education - Must meet education standards for the MOS or option for which you are enlisting.

USMC TO ARNG TRANSITION

- Over 60 Marine Corps MOS's translate directly to an ARNG MOS
- Warrant Officer opportunities for qualified Marines
- Commissioned Officer Producing Programs
- Units located in 54 US States and Territories
- Availability of combat arms vacancies makes the ARNG a good fit for many Marines leaving active duty
