




During these 10 weeks, you will become physically and mentally stronger — learning to overcome the challenges placed before you. Basic Training instructors teach new Soldiers how to care for themselves and others, to function as a member of a team and to achieve success together. They will provide you with the confidence to succeed in the face of adversity.



Training includes first aid, marksmanship, tactics and other related topics. You will also learn about the customs, traditions and values that all Soldiers live by.
